# T@B PRE-FLIGHT CHECK LIST

Protect your T@B. Take a few minutes before each trip and before leaving the camp ground to make sure your T@B is road-ready. It takes just a few seconds and may prevent the need for repairs!

## Pre-Trip Instructions:

- Remove Screen Room or Awning—secure in trailer
- Secure all camping equipment (chairs, table, grill)
- Secure cargo in trailer
- Dump fresh and grey water tanks
- Take down any hanging items and stow
- Check cabinets for loose articles that may damage trailer during travel
- Secure port-a-potty
- Open all window shades and screens
- Close and secure windows for travel
- Close roof vent
- Lower dinette table and secure
- Turn off all lights
- Turn refrigerator to 12V power
- Put travel peg in refrigerator door
- Disconnect 110v power - store cable
- Turn off LP bottle
- Lock door
- Walk around T@B to see what you have left behind
- Clean your campsite for the next user

## Hook Up Instructions:

- Engage trailer safety brake
- Raise stabilizer jacks
- Raise coupler above hitch ball
- Back vehicle slowly into position
- Lower jack and secure coupler to hitch ball
- Lock coupler with T@B coupler lock
- Attach safety chains to hitch
- Attach break-away cable to hitch
- Attach trailer taillight wiring harness
- Secure wheel chocks for travel
- Raise tongue jack and secure to traveling position (see T@B Tips)
- Check that trailer lights are operating correctly
- Release safety brake
